

ABC Preschool & Kindergarten

Frequently Asked Questions

1. What curriculum is taught?

We teach Saxon Math and Phonics for Kindergarten. Our Bible curriculum is Gospel Light.

2. Do I need to bring school supplies?

We provide all classroom supplies, but your child will need a pocket folder of their choice for papers and homework, a backpack or tote large enough to hold the folder, and a lunch bag or box.

3. Is ABC state accredited?

No, we are not accredited, but have graduated Kindergarten classes since 2005 and our students have prospered in both public and private schools. According to the State Department of Education, the schools have the right to require a placement test for any student coming into their district.

4. How many days will my kindergartener be in school?

ABC is in session 60+ days each school year. We are a parent/teacher cooperative style kindergarten. Our design is to introduce new skills and activities, and have parents work with their children on the off days, supplementing the teaching.

5. Do I have to provide the homework for non-school days?

The teachers will provide supplemental work to be completed at home to account for three additional days per week of instruction/learning in order to meet the State Department of Education's 180-day mark. In addition, parents are encouraged to read with your child daily, play educational games, etc.

6. Will I be kept informed of my child's progress?

Yes. Twice per year you will receive a full progress report. Smaller assessments will be given throughout the year as well.

7. Will my child nap at school?

No. You will not need to bring any kind of nap mat or blanket. Our day is packed full of educational experiences.

8. Will my child take field trips?

Yes. There will be 3-4 field trips this year to enhance the educational experience. Parent volunteers who have completed a background check and proof of insurance will provide transportation.
